

Eames Fine Art Secret Bid Auction

Terms & Conditions

- All artworks displayed on the Eames Fine Art website from Wednesday 14 July 2021 are available for sale as part of our annual Summer Secret Bid Auction.
- Each work is labelled with a lot number, artist, title, description and a condition report. Each work is given a guide 'retail price' which is for your information only. The 'reserve price' is the lowest bid that may be accepted for the work. If a work has no reserve price then there is no lower limit to bids that may be accepted for the piece.
- To make a bid for any of the lots, you need to fill out the 'ENQUIRE' button on the left hand side of the picture you've chosen to click on. In the form that appears please make sure that you fill out your email and phone number so that we can reach you after the auction has ended if you are successful in your bid. Then in the 'message' box please clearly state what bid you'd like to make for the artwork (e.g. "I would like to bid £500 for this work".)
- There is no limit to the number of bids you may submit. Multiple bids for an individual lot are acceptable if you decide to raise your bid.
- Bids may be made online at www.eamesfineart.com until 5pm on Sunday 18 July 2021.
- There will be no additional charges added to the cost of each sale. The successful bid is the final price due for the lot. Where applicable VAT, Artist's Resale Right, and framing costs are included in the retail / reserve price as the artwork is displayed at the auction.
- If you have any trouble about placing a bid or need to ask any questions about a lot or the bidding process you can reach us on 0207 407 6561 or by email on info@eamesfineart.com. (If you are struggling to place a bid you can also send it to us by email to this same address.)
- Eames Fine Art will collate all bids immediately after the auction and winning bidders will be contacted by 6pm on Tuesday 20 July. Please ensure that you can be reached on the contact number / email address you provide.
- Payment of winning bids is due within five working days by cheque, credit/debit card, bank transfer or cash. Artworks will not be released until funds have cleared.
- Once an online form is submitted it forms a written contract between the signatory and Eames Fine Art Ltd to purchase the named artwork at the stated price if this is the highest bid received for the lot.
- In the event of a tied bid, both bidders will be contacted on Monday 19 July and given the opportunity to raise their bid.
- Unsold lots will be available for sale for their reserve prices via the Eames Fine Art website (www.eamesfineart.com) until 11pm on Sunday 1 August 2021. Where an unsold lot has no reserve price, it will be offered at 60% of its guide retail price until 11pm on Sunday 1 August 2021.
- By bidding for a lot you undertake to collect the artwork or arrange for its collection if successful. Works will be available for collection from Eames Fine Art Studio from Tuesday 20 July by appointment. After this time collections may be arranged by appointment. If winners prefer to have their work delivered, then this can be arranged subject to a shipping charge. We are happy to give quotes for this.
- Works bought at this Secret Bid Auction are non-returnable and may not be exchanged for cash or other artworks unless by special consent of Eames Fine Art Ltd.
